The five-year projection for the population in the area is 176,147 representing a change of -0.23% annually from 2021 to 2026. Currently, the population is 48.4% male and 51.6% female.

Current median household income is \$36,554 in the area, compared to \$64,730 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$40,130 in five years, compared to \$72,932 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$54,036 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$60,142 in five years, compared to \$103,679 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$22,678 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$34,136. The per capita income is projected to be \$25,303 in five years, compared to \$39,378 for all U.S. households

Currently, 40.7% of the 94,182 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 37.9%, renter occupied; and 21.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.3% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.2% are renter occupied; and 11.5% are vacant. In 2010, there were 93,844 housing units in the area - 42.1% owner occupied, 38.2% renter occupied, and 19.7% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.16%. Median home value in the area is \$81,859, compared to a median home value of \$264,021 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.82% annually to \$98,747.
